

## Fast Facts Boykanbil Mooring Area

**ABOUT:** The Boykanbil Mooring Area is a category 3 area located in Coombabah Creek adjacent to Jabiru Island in the Designated Mooring Area (DMA) in the Moreton Bay Marine Park.

**CURRENT MOORINGS IN THE AREA:** Twenty-one (21) traditional swing moorings.

**FUTURE CAPACITY:** The Gold Coast Waterways Authority has identified that this site may potentially allow the establishment of up to thirty-one (31) environmentally friendly swing moorings.

**IMPORTANT:** The 2014 Buoy Mooring Review identified certain instances where proposed extensions to GCWA buoy mooring areas do not align with Designated Mooring Areas within the Moreton Bay Marine Park and/or with the current management of declared Fish Habitat Areas. GCWA and Department of National Parks, Sport and Racing (NPSR) are working together to resolve these issues, which involves a legislative review process and public consultation by NPSR. In the interim, GCWA may only grant buoy mooring authorities in the Designated Mooring Area.

*(Note: The establishment of additional buoy moorings at this site is subject to a range of factors; for example, vessel character, natural occurrences such as ongoing shoaling, and marine development.)*
