The Gold Coast Waterways Authority (GCWA) is investing \$35.3 million in projects over four years to sustain, enhance and promote our waterways.

About the Project

This project involves the major maintenance and repair of the 26 larger beacons within the Gold Coast Seaway and Southern Broadwater i.e. the North Channel and South Channel as well as the 2 training wall light houses at the Seaway entrance. The scope includes but is not limited to the replacement of ladders and platforms, blast and repaint works.

Benefits to the Community

- Sustain safe navigational access into Gold Coast Waterways
- Reduce ongoing maintenance and cost to tax payers.
- Improve occupational health and safety for maintenance workers (safe access).

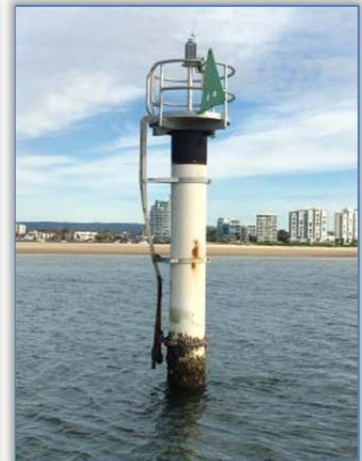
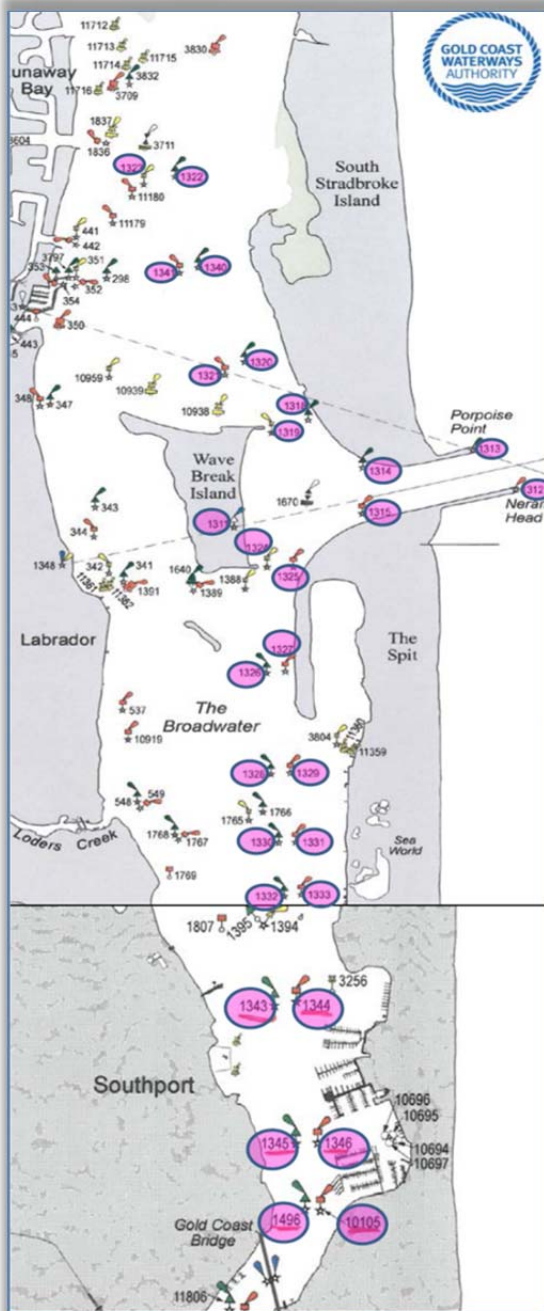
Our Vision
