

# The Coomera River

The Gold Coast is a waterways city—our waterways support vital industries like tourism, recreation and marine services and they provide spaces for people to live, work and play.

The Coomera River is a key part of our waterways network. Like all our beautiful waterways, speed limits and other regulations apply for the Coomera River system to ensure safer navigation and equitable access.

The lower estuary of the Coomera River divides into north and south branches around Coomera Island, which forms part of the southern Moreton Bay Marine Park.

## SPEED LIMITS (NORTH BRANCH)

- 40 knots for vessels less than 8 metres in length
- 6 knots for all vessels 8 metres in length and over

## SPEED LIMITS (SOUTH BRANCH)

- 30 knots for vessels less than 6.5 metres in length
- 6 knots for vessels 6.5 metres in length and over
- 6 knots for all vessels on the narrow channel behind the small unnamed island near the entrance to Hope Harbour Marina

**Please note:** freestyling and wave jumping are prohibited in the Coomera River.
