

Fast Facts ⓘ Paradise Point Mooring Area

ABOUT: The Paradise Point mooring area is a category 3 area located within the Coomera River (South Branch) near Paradise Point.

CURRENT MOORINGS IN THE AREA: There are currently 7 traditional buoy moorings in the mooring area.

FUTURE CAPACITY: For this mooring area, there would seem to be enough space and depth for up to 12 environmentally friendly moorings; however, this would depend on the depth and type, length and draft of the moored vessels.

Note: The establishment of buoy moorings in this area may be affected by several factors, such as sand movements and shoaling, increasing levels of water traffic, existing access to infrastructure, obstacles to safer vessel swing radius (for example, groynes), and future marine development. Depth may also increase vessel swing radius thereby reducing vessel numbers. GCWA will ensure buoy mooring locations are at least 30 metres from the main channel where the speed limit is 30 knots for vessel less than 6.5 metres in length.
