

# The Seaway Promenade Project

Construction of the Seaway Promenade has been completed and it is now open for the community to enjoy.

The Queensland Government and Gold Coast Waterways Authority have provided an iconic destination for recreational access and visitor experiences at the Top of the Spit with the promenade improvements.

## Benefits:

This project has delivered the following community benefits in accordance with the community's vision for The Spit:

- Safe and equitable access along the Seaway south wall with a 4m wide and 670m long promenade pathway to the Seaway beacon
- Enhanced foreshore recreational open space including shelters and seating
- The Seaway Promenade connects people to the marine environment with shelters, seating, and landscaped areas where people can sit back and soak up the views
- Offering unobstructed views south along the city's coastline, north to the scenic beaches of South Stradbroke Island and along the Seaway to the hinterland
- An additional set of emergency access stairs into the Seaway
- Improvements to stabilise the sand dunes and reduce wind-blown sand.
