Introduction

The *Maritime Safety Queensland Act 2002* provides Maritime Safety Queensland with power to do anything necessary or convenient to be done for the performance of its functions. This includes the design of specialised marine safety signs for use on waterways.

The Catalogue of Approved Marine Safety Signs (the Catalogue) has been produced by the Maritime Services Section of Maritime Safety Queensland (MSQ), following consultation with all regional offices of MSQ.

The Catalogue contains marine safety signs to cover the management and regulation of the operations and activities of vessels on Queensland waters, consistent with all gazette notices published for speed limits and prohibitions, as at 1 January 2014.

The Catalogue only contains designs for marine safety signs approved for use in Queensland waters by the General Manager of Maritime Safety Queensland. These designs are consistent with relevant Australian standards with respect to shape, colours, lettering and symbols, as far as practicable. A regional office must not erect a marine sign that departs from these designs, without approval from the General Manager.

The Catalogue classifies marine safety signs according to their function:

Regulatory signs are used to regulate the operations and activities of vessels by indicating when or where a legal requirement applies. A failure to comply with a regulatory sign constitutes an offence against marine safety legislation.

Generally, regulatory signs are rectangular shaped with black letters or symbols, or both, with or without red annulus and slash, and with or without arrows, on white retroreflective background.

Included in this classification are marine safety signs that indicate the end of a legal requirement (for example, the END MARINE SPEED LIMIT sign).

Warning signs are used to warn waterway users of potentially hazardous conditions, or conditions that require caution and prudent seamanship, and may necessitate a reduction in speed to ensure safe navigation.

Generally, warning signs for waterways are rectangular shaped with black letters or symbols, or both, and black border on yellow retroreflective background.

Included in this classification are the warning signs for overhead powerlines.

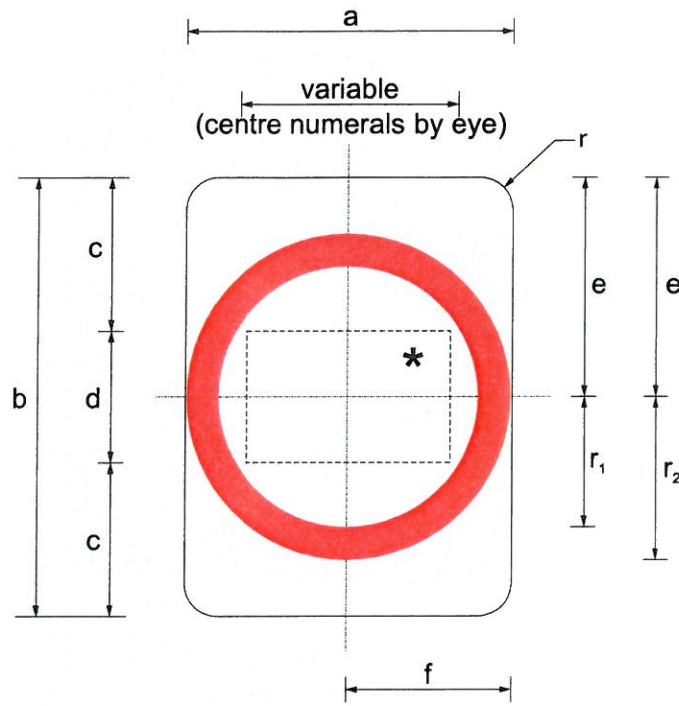
Information signs inform or advise waterway users of matters of interest to the operation or activities of their vessels. These signs are individually designed to convey the appropriate marine safety message.

Generally, information signs for waterways are rectangular shaped with black or blue letters, with corresponding black or blue border, on white retroreflective background.

Suggestions or recommendations for new designs of marine safety signs must follow the basic shape,

colours lettering and symbols described for these particular classifications. This ensures consistency across MSQ's regions, which means that waterway users can easily recognise the different types of marine safety signs
