

Doug Jennings Park Ongoing Infrastructure Improvements Stage 3

As part of the ongoing work to revitalise Doug Jennings Park, we're delivering the next stage of ongoing infrastructure improvements.

Following the success of Stage 1: The Spit Amenities Block & Sewerage Connection and Stage 2: the Rehabilitation Moondarewa Spit, Stage 3 of this project involves:-

- Re-alignment of the Ring Road which runs along the north west side of the park
- Construction of formalised parking bays along the Ring Road
- Sealing the gravel carpark immediately north of the main carpark
- Construction of a shared footpath to run the length of the Seaway wall
- Installation of vehicle barriers and traffic management devices
- Installation of minor park infrastructure
- Landscaping and tree planting

A detailed concept plan illustrating the planned works is provided overleaf.

Benefits

- Significantly improve the public amenity of the park
- Reduce public health and safety issues
- Reduce anti-social behaviour
- Protect & enhance environmental values
- Protect public infrastructure

Impacts of the Project

During construction, the works area and rock wall will be closed off to the public. GCWA plans to stage the works to reduce the disruption to the public. Temporary pedestrian access to important areas will be provided where possible.
