

A New Pontoon for Alberton

The Gold Coast Waterways Authority is improving access to the waterways by constructing a new pontoon at Alberton.

Located at Alberton Road, Alberton, this project involves:-

- Investigation, options analysis, design and approvals
- Construction of a new pontoon

A conceptual plan is shown overleaf depicting the proposed structure.

Benefits

- The brand new pontoon structure will meet growing demand for recreational access to the Logan River
- A flood resilient queuing facility to maximise efficient launching and retrieval practices

Impacts

- A barge and piling rig will operate in the waterway which may restrict waterways access during the construction works period (approximately four weeks)
- Access to the boat ramp for both vehicles and vessels will not be affected
