## Doug Jennings Park Ongoing Infrastructure Improvements Stage 4

As part of the ongoing work to revitalise Doug Jennings Park, we are delivering the next stage of ongoing infrastructure improvements.

Following the success of Stage 1: The Spit Amenities Block & Sewerage Connection, Stage 2: the Rehabilitation of Moondarewa Spit and Stage 3: Upgrade of the Ring Road and Carpark, Stage 4 of this project will provide:-

- An upgrade of the road running between Seaworld Drive and Moondarewa Spit
- Additional formalised parking bays along the road
- Upgrade of the Seaworld Drive intersection
- A shared footpath running around the perimeter of the park
- Vehicle barriers and traffic management devices
- Landscaping and planting of native shade trees
- Minor park infrastructure including picnic tables and park benches

### Benefits

- Significantly improve the public amenity of the park
- Reduce public health and safety issues
- Reduce antisocial behaviour
- Protect and enhance environmental values
- Protect public infrastructure
- Improve traffic flow to alleviate congestion

### Impacts

- During construction, access to certain areas of the park will be restricted and the road between Seaworld Drive and Moondarewa Spit will be one-way.
