# Tipplers Pontoon Replacement Project

The Gold Coast Waterways Authority (GCWA) is upgrading the Tipplers Pontoon by replacing the pontoon module. We're resolving a recurring listing issue that occurs due to a failure of the submerged floatation bags.

The new pontoon module will be of a similar size with upgraded specifications to improve its usability and overall functionality for users.

## Benefits:

- Replacement of problematic infrastructure
- Improved access to the Tipplers campground for recreational vessels
- Engineered to the latest standards to reduce maintenance
- Helps meet increased demand for waterways destinations within the Moreton Bay Marine Park.

## Impacts:

- Temporary closure of the pontoon whilst the new module is installed
- The campground and surrounding foreshore of South Stradbroke Island will remain open
- Some temporary restrictions in and around the pontoon structure when the old pontoon module is removed and the new pontoon module is installed for approximately 2 weeks (see attached map)
- There will be some noise due to construction activities.

### Alternative pontoon facilities nearby:
