



# Guide to using Doug Jennings Park

Located on The Spit at the Gold Coast, Doug Jennings Park is a popular destination for tourists and locals seeking to fish, dive, surf and swim in the Broadwater and ocean, or for activities such as picnicking, walking and relaxing with the family.

Doug Jennings Park is an important coastal recreational environment and a valuable resource to the Gold Coast community.

At approximately 30 ha in size, this park is a prominent sandy coastal peninsula on the eastern side of the Broadwater, positioned at the southern boundary of the Moreton Bay Marine Park.



# Rules apply to all users of Doug Jennings Park



Gold Coast Waterways Authority (GCWA) has adopted the 'Trust Land Protection and Use Model By-law 2009' to keep the park in the best possible condition. The model by-law prohibits various activities in Doug Jennings Park and provides penalties for those who choose to ignore the rules.

## Prohibited activities include:



Commercial activities



Littering



Lighting fire



Overnight parking



Camping



Having a dog off a leash
