Alberton Pontoon module replacement

The Gold Coast Waterways Authority is replacing the pontoon module at Alberton on the Logan River.

This popular marine facility will be repaired after it was structurally damaged during the 2022 floods.

The existing pontoon module will be removed and replaced with an upgraded module of the same size that offers enhanced functionality for recreational users.

BENEFITS

- Replacement of damaged infrastructure
- Upgraded specification to improve performance and life of structure
- Supports recreational activities such as fishing
- Maintains access for vessel owners that use the Alberton boat ramp and our waterways

IMPACTS

- 2-3 day closure during construction
- Some access restrictions while construction barges and work boats operate around the structure
- There may be minor noise impacts from demolition and construction activities
