

PROJECT FACT SHEET

Southport Broadwater Parklands pontoon repairs

Gold Coast Waterways Authority is repairing the pontoon structure at Southport Broadwater Parklands. The pontoon module and abutment has suffered structural damage and requires replacement.

This popular marine facility providing access to the Broadwater will be repaired through replacement of the existing pontoon module and abutment.

The new infrastructure will be a similar size, with upgraded specifications to enhance its usability, aesthetics, and overall functionality for recreational users.

BENEFITS

- Replacement of damaged infrastructure
- Upgraded specification to improve performance and life of structure
- Supports recreational activities such as sporting events, fishing and access to the waterway
- Supports recreational vessel owners that use the adjacent boat ramp and our waterways

IMPACTS

- Temporary pontoon closure during construction
- Some access restrictions around the pontoon structure during the construction period (approximately 16 weeks) due to construction barges and machinery
- There may be minor noise impacts from demolition and construction activities
