As part of ongoing works to revitalise Doug Jennings Park, we will be delivering crucial landscaping improvements to continue creating beautiful and relaxed spaces for visitors to enjoy. These works are consistent with the outcomes sought by The Spit Master Plan 2019.

THE IMPROVEMENT WORKS INCLUDE:

- Landscaping and planting of native shade trees and shrubs
- Installation of new turf areas
- Shaping of trees to enhance and revitalise
- Aerating, weed management and fertilising turf areas to improve overall health and resilience

BENEFITS

- Significantly improve the public amenity of the park
- Reduce public health and safety issues
- Protect and enhance environmental values
- Protect public infrastructure

IMPACTS

- During construction, access to certain areas of the park will be restricted including the number of car parks is likely to be reduced to enable the improvements to be undertaken
- Some noise will be generated by construction works
