Paradise Point Boat Harbour Mooring Area

ABOUT: The Paradise Point Boat Harbour mooring area is a category 3 area located within the Paradise Point Boat Harbour near Paradise Point.

CURRENT MOORINGS IN THE AREA: There are currently 26XXX traditional buoy moorings in the mooring area.

FUTURE CAPACITY: This mooring area is limited by water depth, fairway access and watercraft congestion. There would seem to be enough space and depth for up to 20 environmentally friendly moorings; however, this would depend on the type, length and draft of the moored vessels.

Note: The establishment of buoy moorings in this area may be affected by several factors, such as ongoing availability of the access fairway to pontoons for Lindsay Parade properties, sand movements and shoaling, increasing levels of water traffic, and future marine development. Because of depth, access and congestion issues, GCWA will condition a maximum vessel length of 10 metres for all buoy mooring authorities in this mooring area (except for a small number of historical approvals).
