

PROJECT FACT SHEET

Tallebudgera (Murlong Crescent) Boat Ramp and Floating Walkway upgrade.

Gold Coast Waterways Authority is upgrading the boat ramp and floating walkway at Murlong Park, Palm Beach.

Murlong Crescent boat ramp and floating walkway are popular marine facilities that provide access to Tallebudgera Creek. Due to structural damage, the existing boat ramp will be replaced, while the floating walkway and abutment will be upgraded.

BENEFITS

- Upgrading and maintaining boating facilities is an important part of ensuring safer, navigable access for waterway users.
- The new infrastructure at Murlong Crescent will be designed to meet current specifications and standards.
- The replacement of the boat ramp and the upgrade of the floating walkway will enhance their usability, aesthetics and overall functionality for accessing Tallebudgera Creek.

IMPACTS

- Temporary closures of the boat ramp and floating walkway will be in place while works are undertaken.
- During the works period there will be restricted access to the area.
- Some noise impacts from demolition, construction and piling are expected.
