

Cavill Avenue Pontoon Repair.

Gold Coast Waterways Authority is repairing the pontoon structure at the western end of Cavill Avenue, Surfers Paradise. This project involves undertaking maintenance activities to address structural damages.

The Cavill Avenue Pontoon is a popular marine facility, providing access to the Nerang River. The pontoon structure will be repaired through maintenance of the pontoon modules and structure.

BENEFITS

- The enhanced infrastructure at Cavill Avenue will be of a similar size to the existing one, with upgraded specifications.

- Temporary closure of the pontoon will be in place while works are undertaken.
- Some noise impacts during the maintenance activities are expected.
