

Cavill Avenue Pontoon Repair

Gold Coast Waterways Authority is repairing the pontoon structure at the western end of Cavill Avenue, Surfers Paradise.

The Cavill Avenue pontoon is a popular marine facility, providing access to the Nerang River. Repairs to the pontoon were undertaken in June 2024. Gold Coast Waterways Authority will require a closure of this pontoon on Tuesday 29 October and Wednesday 30 October, to complete final maintenance works.

BENEFITS

- Maintaining recreational and commercial boating facilities is an important part of ensuring safer, navigable access for waterway users.
- The repair of the pontoon structure will ensure the functionality for recreational and commercial waterways users in the Surfers Paradise area is maintained.

IMPACTS

- Temporary closure of the pontoon will be in place while remaining maintenance works are undertaken.
- Some noise impacts during the maintenance activities are expected.
